Part 3: The Flesh Profits Nothing

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Full Text (for reading on your own)

The Mind of Christ

In the Old Covenant God says “*For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways*” (Isa 55:8) but in the New Covenant the Father says we have the mind of Christ! “For *“who has known the mind of the Lord that he may instruct Him?” But we have the mind of Christ.*” (1 Cor. 2:16)

Another time I had a similar thought “there is nothing new under the Sun” and I heard the Lord said “that’s Old Covenant because *‘Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him.’*” (1 Cor. 2:9)

So, yes His thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are His ways our ways ... unless you have the mind of Christ!

That was a major transition for me from Psalms 37:4 “*Delight yourself also in the Lord, and He shall give you the desires of your heart.*” In our early walk with God, most believers spend a lot of time learning to deny our desires. And actually dying to yourself is actually a big part of your early walk with God. Over time, as we delight ourselves in the Lord, more and more of our desires are actually from Him!

So, yes His thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are His ways our ways ... unless you have and are walking in the mind of Christ!

Testimony: Multiple Job Offers (Derrick)

Derrick struggled for a long time to find a job in the career field he wanted. His family pressed into tithing - really committed to giving the whole tithe. The Lord started blessing them (financially) by taking them down a path that was truly “glory to glory.” God made connections with just the right people. He gave Derrick the right skills at the right time, and lined everything up just perfectly. “He set me Derrick up for success as he was faithful to tithe.

More recently, Derrick’s previous employer had decided to outsource his department. Derrick was not at all phased by it but instead was confident that the Lord was going to provide something better than he currently had. God did not let him down! Immediately Derrick had multiple people tearing

down his door to try to get him to work for them! He ended up just picking the one that felt right for him - that he had absolute peace on. It truly is above and beyond what he even expected; it's so good! God is really blessing his socks off with this new position!

Testimony: Child Prays and Pain Leaves (Nevaeh)

A couple weeks ago, Nevaeh was pulling out her drawer to get her clothes. When she was pulling it out she pulled it a little too far and the drawer fell on her foot and her foot hurt so bad!

"I just laid my hands on it and I commanded the pain to leave. And as soon as I took my hands off I couldn't feel it (the pain) anymore!"

Testimony: Dad Prays for Son and Pain Leaves (Nehemiah and Kenton)

A few weeks ago Nehemiah was getting ready for bed and felt some pain in his feet. Although Nehemiah is a tough guy, he said the pain in his feet was probably an "8" on a scale from 1-10. He was writhing in pain.

Nehemiah asked his dad Kenton to pray for him. Kenton prayed for him and "the pain got away!" Nehemiah said that after his dad prayed for him the pain was now "probably 0" on a scale from 1-10! Praise God!

From Kenton's perspective, it was a late night. The kids were well passed their bedtime. This was not exactly the perfect "high faith" time to minister healing to someone. Kenton thought "you asked me to pray for you; I'm not going to deny you that so we are going to go after this."

So Kenton took just a few seconds to recalibrate. During that recalibration he began to pray for him and lay hands on him and had a picture of Jesus RIGHT THERE and Jesus spoke to Kenton "do you know that pain belongs to Me?"

The realization came "Jesus come get your pain. This doesn't belong to Nehemiah; this is Your's. This is Your sickness. This is Your pain." Kenton realized that pain was purchased by Jesus ... it now belongs to Him! He owns it and He has NO PROBLEM taking it off of you!

PRAY (RECEIVE) RIGHT NOW ... "Jesus, you purchased this sickness I have been experiencing . You purchased this pain I have been experiencing. It belongs to You. I command all this pain to go back to You! I invite you to come and take Your pain Jesus - take Your pain and remove it from me! And I receive what you give me - which is NOT pain, but healing in Jesus' Name! Healing be released in my body right now in Jesus' Name!" AMEN!

Don't Be Afraid to Measure: Great Grace Produces Great RESULTS!

Do you know one of the best ways (if not THE best way) you can grow in the healing ministry? Keep tabs of success.

One of the best ways (if not THE best way) you can grow in the prophetic is to record the prophetic words that you give or get.

The best way you can grow in dreams and dream interpretation is to record your dreams!

When you start to record it, it allows it to be improved upon, reflected upon, and actionable. You start to know what worked and what didn't work. You know where you had breakthrough and where you didn't have breakthrough.

Don't be afraid to record! Great grace actually produces great results!

A confusion that some people get into with grace is they think "well it's grace so I'm not measuring." No, no, no ... because of our right standing with God and connection to Jesus, it actually produces GREAT RESULTS!

If you have a Christian boss you wouldn't go to your Christian boss and say "I'm sorry I don't have any sales, but have grace for me." No, the root of grace ought to produce great sales!

Do you see it? Don't be afraid to measure the fruit of grace - for instance what you are seeing as it relates to praying for healing, etc.

Pastoral Thoughts on Growing in Grace

Be patient with the grace series. Remember that Ephesians 2:7 says "*that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace...*" In other words, it is going to take all of eternity to discover the exceeding riches of His grace. "Why hasn't Peter covered it all yet???" I have a hint for you!

If it is going to take all of eternity to see the exceeding riches of His grace it is going to take any minister a lot longer than a few months to even start to touch it. It's just so big! We are going to spend all of eternity discovering it!

Even at the end of these series on grace (regardless of how long we stay on this topic), we're only going to scratch the surface. Even just scratching the surface will be POWERFUL in each of our lives! But it will still only be just the surface of the depths that we will discover in the ages to come!

Another perspective I want to remind us of is that grace is not just a linear, outline, type message. Probably a good way to think of it is as facets of a diamond. For me, in my mind, I have it broken down into about 6 facets. But even in focusing on 1 facet of a 6 sided diamond you'd see a few other

facets in the periphery of your vision that you need to speak to as you speak about the main facet you're focusing on. So I was thinking "so I'll just speak to one facet at a time and just touch on the periphery."

But I was praying and saying "Lord, where are we at in this sermon series" and I instantly heard "Ezekiel 4:9." That verse talks about the 6 different grains that God instructed Ezekiel to place in a jar and he would take a measured amount of the combination of those grains to give to himself to eat from time to time.

So on one hand I can focus on facets but on the other hand there are these different grains in the pot (so-to-speak) and on any given week I will be pulling out an amalgamation of these facets of grace. You sort of need all of it bit-by-bit so that it is the whole food. (Amazingly, the mixture of 6 grains God prescribed to Ezekiel contained ALL of the essential amino acids!)

The final perspective I would share concerning the grace series of messages is that grace is an operating system, not just a program.

On your phone you have apps and operating systems. To install a new app you don't need a new operating system, but to install a new operating system, you need a reboot. Grace is an operating system teaching, not an app. This makes grace challenging, because like an operating system, it starts to challenge the way a lot of the apps in your life will work.

For instance, if someone is a genuine believer and does not know grace, they have an app in their life called "the stop sinning app." With that app they put boundaries around areas in their life they think they may have a propensity to sin in, and stay away from that area, and feel condemned if they think about it. That's their coping mechanism that has caused them to perhaps stop sinning (in action) about that thing but their heart hasn't been transformed.

And there's nothing wrong with that ... if someone's struggling with some sinful lifestyle I've encouraged people before to get rid of their access to that thing. You know ... if your right hand causes to sin, cut it off. Sometimes people need to put some boundaries around something for a MOMENT, but that's not the heart transformation.

So brothers and sisters who are genuine in the Lord, and are starting to grace, but have previously been under the law and under performance will still have an app running in their mind called the "stop sinning app." So if you start teaching this brother or sister about grace they will start to realize that the "stop sinning app" they've been using daily is not going to run on the grace operating system. So they will start to wonder - genuinely - "well, how do you not sin?"

It's truly a good, genuine question from them. They are thinking "you're telling me I'm not going to keep a list of rules, and out of my own flesh and will power keep myself from sinning?" Folks were wondering similar things with Paul "shall we go on and sin then?" Certainly not!

Galatians 5:16 is a powerful scripture. It says that if you walk by the Spirit you will NOT gratify the desires of the flesh. If you focus on Jesus and what He's done, you won't walk in sin.

The fruit of the flesh is self-evident. Paul was saying "we don't even need to talk about that - we know what that stuff is. But the fruit of the Spirit ... and against the fruit of the Spirit, there is no law!" In other words, you will be fulfilling every law you could have ever tried to adhere to if you walk in the fruit of the Spirit!

Well how are you going to have the fruit of the Spirit? "By trying hard, Peter, by trying hard!" No you won't!

You are going to walk in the fruit of the Spirit by looking upon Jesus, seeing who He is, and seeing who you are in Him! As you see who you are in Him as a born-again believer, it transforms you and your desires! You awake to your righteous identity and you sin not!

What I'm trying to say is to be patient with yourself with this sermon series because for some of us this is going to be unseating some apps that we've been running on an old operating system. Be patient with yourself. Sometimes some things need to shut down before a new operating system can boot up. It takes some time to meditate on these things!

Mark Crawford says "followthrough is the key to breakthrough." If you get one thing from a sermon, isn't it worth it? Every mature believer I know is looking for one thing. That's humility. "If I get one thing - one thing will make it so worthwhile!" Sometimes you get more than one thing, but the heart that in humility is looking even for one thing will find as much as can be found.

When you get that one thing that pierces through a wall in your heart or confusion in your mind, the whole wall generally won't come down until you follow through on that one thing. The breakthrough has started for you the first time you heard something in a sermon, but you have to come back at that by meditating in that truth over and over.

After the last sermon someone was telling me "there was something you said that I needed to hear!" They went back and listened through the sermon a couple times to try to find it. Once they found the phrase they got their breakthrough. It registered as a breakthrough phrase for them when they heard it the first time but they got their actual breakthrough when they followed up on it!

So I want to encourage you: I'm giving you some tips of icebergs but you're not going to get the root of the iceberg except through following up on it, meditation, etc. If Holy Spirit speaks something to your heart, go after it!

Bold Faith Comes from No Condemnation!

Boldness is to be “so confident as ***to suggest a lack of shame***” according to the Oxford Dictionary. Boldness is not something we put on or work up. It is simply the absence of condemnation.

As a born-again believer, the faith of Jesus Christ lives in you. If you don't have condemnation ON you, bold faith comes OUT OF you!

*“There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, **who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.**”* (Rom. 8:1) For years, many of us have thought that means there is no condemnation for those who don't sin. If you read the next 5 or 6 verses of Romans 8 you see that walking according to the flesh means to set your mind on things of the flesh - in other words, things like: **your** performance, **your** strength, **your** might, **your** ability, what **you've** done, and **your** obedience! That's a mind set on the flesh.

But when you set your mind on **HIS** performance, **HIS** obedience, and what **HE** has accomplished on your behalf, that's a mind set on the Spirit. That is also “walking according to the Spirit.” If you walk according to the Spirit you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. (Gal. 5:16)

Now I also gave you a key scripture last time to help you set your mind on the Spirit. Romans 5:19 *“For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so also **by one Man's obedience** many will be made righteous.”* Who's the ONE Man?

Your righteousness as a born-again believer has ZERO to do with your obedience. If you get that, it will change your life. Don't look upon your obedience; look upon Jesus' obedience and you will walk according to the Spirit and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh and you will step out of condemnation!

As believers, we are righteous in reality (“there is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus”) but we will not be righteous in experience unless we walk according to the Spirit - unless we set our mind on what Jesus has accomplished, to look upon Him!

When we have a righteousness-consciousness, two amazing things happen: (1) the righteous are as bold as a lion. (2) The righteous will live by faith! *“For in it (the Gospel) the righteousness of God is revealed **from** faith **to** faith; as it is written, “The just shall live by faith.”* When you put faith in Jesus, righteousness comes into your life. In other words, the righteousness of God is revealed FROM faith.

Also, “the righteousness of God is revealed TO faith.” In other words, when you realize that you are righteous, faith is released in TO your life. The righteous will live by faith!

The righteousness revelation releases BOLD FAITH in your life!

If we want to get this, we have to remind ourselves “I am not the ONE! I’m not the ONE! It’s not my obedience that has made me righteous! It’s not me! I’m not the ONE! He’s the ONE! Jesus is the ONE! It was HIS obedience that made me righteous! I’m not even part of the righteousness equation ... He’s the ONE!”

If you have not spent time meditating on this, I would encourage you to! If you start to feel separation ... if you start to feel condemnation, you will notice that you have started to gaze inside yourself. That’s why that’s happening - you are setting your mind on your flesh and it’s producing condemnation in your life. You’re not condemned in actuality but your experience becomes as one who is condemned. The wicked (or ones who think they are condemned) flee though no one pursues but the righteous (or the righteous who know in their heart that they are righteous) are as bold as a lion!

Today’s Message: It’s the Spirit that gives life!

I am here to tell you that it is the Spirit that gives life and the flesh profits NOTHING!

The Spirit gives life, the flesh profits nothing.

Jesus told us in John 6:63 that it is the Spirit that gives life. The flesh profits nothing.

The Spirit: **HIS** performance, **HIS** obedience, and what **HE** has accomplished.

The flesh: **your** performance, **your** strength, **your** might, **your** ability, what **you’ve** done, and **your** obedience ... profits nothing!

It’s the Spirit that gives life.

So, I want to tell you some things the flesh will NEVER do for you.

In the previous message, I made a bold claim: the reason we are experiencing condemnation (even though it’s not for us) is because we are looking to ourselves - because we are looking to our flesh. I’m saying if you will just gaze upon what Jesus has accomplished you will experience something totally different in your life and bold faith will start to flow out of you.

So I want to follow up on the previous message by further clarifying the flesh because this is a very different paradigm than what we might be used to. Although it is a different paradigm, the Word of God is so clear, so let’s dive in!

Works of the Flesh will NEVER Produce Right Standing with God!

Romans 3:20 (NASB) *“because by the **works of the Law no flesh will be justified** in His sight; for through the Law comes the knowledge of sin.”*

When you see the Bible say “works of the Law” it is talking about looking to your performance, to your flesh in order to be right before God (in order to be righteous). NO FLESH will be justified by works of the Law, for through the Law comes the knowledge of sin. The Law’s purpose was to bring knowledge of sin - to show us that we needed a Savior and that the works of our flesh were not going to work for us! Who did the works of the Law work for? Jesus! Jesus fulfilled the works of the Law actually. That’s why He said He did not come to abolish the Law but to fulfill it.

Romans 3:21-22a *“But now the **righteousness of God apart from the law is revealed**, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, even the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to all and on all who believe.”*

The righteousness of God (which we NOW have) apart from the law is revealed! BUT NOW - means after Jesus died and rose again. This is a different sort of righteous NOW. It had to be prophesied by Moses and the prophets because it was NOT YET then. This sort of righteousness is completely APART from the law. This is the righteousness of God that is through faith in Christ! It is for all who believe!!

Romans 3:28 (NASB) *“For we maintain that a man is justified by faith **apart from works of the Law.**”*

Faith justifies (makes righteous) ... WITHOUT ANY WORKS ADDED TO IT! If you add works to grace, grace is no longer grace.

Galatians 2:16 *“knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law but by faith in Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, that we might be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law; **for by the works of the law no flesh shall be justified.**”*

Your right standing with God will NEVER come from the works of your flesh. It will never come from your obedience. Your obedience is NOT part of the equation.

One of the reasons the enemy hurls accusations our way is to try to get us to look to our flesh. He will give you disturbing thought. He might know that you won’t do it, but He wants you to feel bad that you even had the thought. Why? Because it will cause you to look at your flesh and analyze yourself - and step out of the flow grace in doing so!

Galatians 5:8 *“this persuasion **does not come from Him** who calls you.”*

All of Galatians is talking about the works of the law vs. basically just hearing with faith. This persuasion (to operate according to the works of the law - to focus on your flesh and your performance) does NOT come from Him who calls you! God is not leading you into a performance-based relationship. God is not leading you into working according to works of the law and focusing on your flesh. This persuasion is NOT coming from Heaven. This persuasion does not come from Him who calls you.

Galatians 5:18 *“But if you are **led by the Spirit**, you are not under the law.”*

I heard this recently and thought “wow, I never saw that!” If you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. It’s what we saw in Galatians 5:8 as well: if Holy Spirit is leading you, He is not placing you under the law! Holy Spirit is not placing you under the law!

The law is not for a righteous person (1 Tim. 1:9). The ministry of the Holy Spirit is *“the ministry of righteousness.”* (2 Cor. 3:7-11). Holy Spirit is convicting the world of sin because they have not believed in Jesus’ work on the Cross but He’s convicting believers of **RIGHTEOUSNESS!**

The law is not going to work to bring right standing for anyone! By works of the flesh, no man will be made righteous. Holy Spirit knows this and He is not leading any believers to live under the law - that persuasion does NOT come from Him who calls you!

Righteous Living Never Comes from Works of the Flesh

Righteous living never comes from works of the flesh. Living apart from sin - sin going away in your life is never coming from works of the flesh.

Romans 6:14 *“For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.”*

Remember we read before that “by works of the Law no flesh will be justified. Sin has dominion over the people that are trying to perform according to their flesh. That’s where sin gets dominion. That’s where sin gets rulership in someone’s life. Sin is strengthened by focusing on our flesh. The strength of sin is the law.

I know this sounds crazy. Trying to live according to the law is not a neutral. Romans 4:4 say *“Now to him who works, the wages are not counted as grace but as debt.”* Trying to work is a debt not a neutral. If you try to live according to the law you will be giving sin a foothold in your life actually. We don’t think of it like that, but it IS like that. You might think “well that’s just from one verse, Peter.” OK, well let’s look at Romans 7:5 too:

Romans 7:5 *“For when we were in the flesh, the sinful passions which were aroused by the law were at work in our members to bear fruit to death.”*

When we were walking according to the flesh, the sinful passions which were aroused BY THE LAW were at work in our members to bear fruit to death! The law itself is holy, but the flesh - **your** performance, **your** strength, **your** might, **your** ability, what **you've** done, and **your** obedience - profits nothing! It's the Spirit that gives life!

It's earnest believers that try to bring profit into their walk with God but if you try to do it the wrong way you can be sincere, but sincerely wrong - and your efforts will not produce what you thought they were going to produce.

Romans 8:6 *"For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace."*

To be thinking about your performance produces death but to be thinking about His performance is LIFE and PEACE. The flesh profits nothing. It's the Spirit that gives life!

Your flesh, your obedience is POWERLESS to produce righteous living. It's a genuine believer that wants to live rightly before God but it's genuinely wrong believer who thinks they can do it through works of the flesh and self-effort.

Your flesh will never make you in right standing with God. Colossians says "as you've received Christ, so walk in Him." Your flesh will also never make you walk in a holy way with God; it will never make you walk in good works to walk according to your flesh. It was by the Spirit that you've been saved. Will you now be perfected by the flesh Paul asks in Galatians. Will you now be brought to completion by the flesh?

Romans 8:3 *"For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh"*

The law actually could make someone righteous. But no man was able to be justified by the law because it was weakened through their flesh. But God did it! No one's flesh (except Christ) has ever accomplished the law! Christ fulfilled the righteous requirements of the law which made Him the perfect sacrifice for our sins!

Romans 13:14 *"But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts."*

Believers are trying to walk free from sin. How do you do it? Put on the Lord Jesus! Set your eyes upon Jesus! That's how you make no provision for the flesh to fulfill its lusts - by walking according to the Spirit!

(I understand sometimes people that have had a problem may need to shut the door on practical access to something - and that can be an interpretation of this verse - to make no provision for the flesh), but to see the real heart change you are going to have to look upon Jesus to see who

you are in Him. As you see who you are in Him, you will awake to your righteousness in Christ and stop sinning (1 Cor. 15:34)

The flesh profits nothing. It won't produce right standing between you and God - ever. The flesh profits nothing. The flesh will not cause you to produce good works. Focusing on your flesh will not make you walk rightly with God. It will not make you walk according to who you are in Christ. It is the Spirit - focusing on Christ - that gives life!

Focusing on the Flesh Sabotages Your Faith

Hebrews 12:2 *“Looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.”*

When you look to Jesus, faith is begun in your life and faith is brought to completion. Faith leaps in your heart when you're looking to Jesus.

By contrast, when you look to yourself, you WILL experience condemnation and condemnation is a great faith inhibitor. There are mold inhibitors and there is a faith inhibitor - it's condemnation. You may think “well, Peter, faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God!” Yes it does come by hearing the Word of God but it will LEAVE by condemnation!

So when we look upon Jesus, faith is authored and finished in our life.

Galatians 5:2 *“Indeed I, Paul, say to you that if you become circumcised, Christ will profit you nothing.”*

If you want a profitable walk with God, you cannot be focused on your flesh. Circumcision is LITERALLY to focus on your flesh! Paul did not mince words about circumcision “I wish they would cut off the whole thing!” Paul was adamant about circumcision because he was not going to allow the gospel to be leavened with the leaven of works.

What Paul was saying here in Galatians 5:2 is that if you receive circumcision - if you operate according to the works of the flesh - if you focus on your flesh, Christ will be of no profit to you! Why? Because all of the profit in Christ comes from FAITH!

Circumcision - to focus on your flesh - is antithetical to faith! When Paul talks about circumcision it is not talking about just the act, it is referring to truly a focus on the flesh. “If I do something in my flesh it will make me right with God.” That's the circumcision mindset.

Galatians 5:6 *“For in Christ Jesus **neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but faith working through love.**”*

Do you see the connection again? Focusing on your flesh is OPPOSITE of faith! Paul was saying “if you are focused on circumcision vs. uncircumcision, let me just redirect you ... it’s FAITH!” Paul knew that if a believer was focused on circumcision vs. uncircumcision they were NOT operating in faith.

What I am trying to say here is that to focus on your flesh will sabotage your faith. This is what the last message was about too - I am just developing it a little bit further with some other scriptures. You cannot build a tent with just one pole, you need multiple supports and that’s where it gets strengthened.

Romans 4:19 *“And not being **weak in faith**, he did not **consider his own body**, already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah’s womb.”*

Abraham, not being weak in faith did not consider his own body! If you look to your flesh it makes you weak in faith! Abraham was not weak in faith but was strong in the faith. What did that strong faith look like? Him not considering his flesh! Abraham not being weak in faith did not consider his own body!

Considering our own flesh ... our own ability ... our own righteousness weakens our faith!

Romans 4:13 (NASB) *“For **the promise** to Abraham or to his descendants that he would be heir of the world **was not through the Law**, but through the righteousness of faith.”*

Romans 4:14 continues *“For if those who are of the law are heirs, **faith is made void** and the **promise made of no effect**”* If you try to do faith by works of the law - by focusing on your flesh and your performance - you void your faith!

“Peter you’re taking these verses literally ...” I am! He really does mean what He says! *“For if those who are of the law are heirs, **faith is made void** and the **promise made of no effect**”* Focusing on your flesh is antithetical to faith. It sabotages your faith!

Romans 8:8 *“So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God.”*

You have to put 2 verses together to get this one. How do you please God? What’s a verse you know about what pleases God?

Hebrews 11:6 says *“apart from faith it is impossible to please God.”*

So those who are in the flesh cannot please God. Apart from faith it is impossible to please God. If you put these two verses together you realize this: **THOSE WHO ARE IN THE FLESH CANNOT WALK IN FAITH!**

Conclusion

If you want to see bold faith rise up in your life in areas you have not walked in it, get out of the flesh! Focusing on **your** performance, **your** strength, **your** might, **your** ability, what **you've** done, and **your** obedience - profits nothing! Focusing on how you are measuring up will cause you to not walk in faith. It's the Spirit - focusing on **HIS** performance, **HIS** obedience, and what **HE** has accomplished that gives life!
